Kulam Tuition: Grades 1 - 8: \$30,725

Learning Resource Fees: Lower School \$4,550. Middle School \$4,750. High School \$4,950.

English Language Program (ELP) Fees: Lower School \$5,250. Middle School \$5,500

Application Fee: \$250 (non-refundable)

Enrollment Fee (new students): There is a \$500 non-refundable/non-transferrable enrollment fee due within two weeks of acceptance for new students. The non-refundable fee reserves a seat for the next school year, subject to satisfactory completion of the current year's academic work, a student's good standing, and family's support of the school's mission and philosophy.

Additionally, each new student is responsible for paying a one-time matriculation fee of \$1,250, which is included in the tuition agreement.

Enrollment Fee (returning students): There is a \$500 non-refundable/non-transferrable re-enrollment fee due to reserve a seat for the next school year. For the 2019-2020 school year, this fee is due by January 11, 2019.

Posnack School Campus Fee: Each family is responsible for an annual campus fee of \$1,350. This fee includes PTO membership and helps to offset security costs including but not limited to cyber structural, access control, and safeguard exterior. The fee is included in the family's tuition agreement.

Posnack School Facility Fee: Each student is responsible for a \$500 facility fee. This fee helps offset technological infrastructure and facility costs. The fee is included in the family's tuition agreement.

Laptop Computer (upper school only): Posnack School requires the use of a tablet or laptop computer in the middle and high school grades. Purchase of the designated devices is the family's responsibility. Laptops and tablets must be purchased from the school specified vendor.

Credit Card Fee: 2.85% convenience fee for all credit card transactions.

Additional Fees: Athletic uniforms, drama participation, student uniforms, overnight and/or long-distance trips, 6th-12th grade books and lab fees, senior dues, and transportation (optional).

Fundraising: It is expected that all families will contribute to the Annual Campaign at their level of financial ability. The Annual Campaign is the cornerstone of Posnack School's advancement program and plays a critical role in helping Posnack School maintain its high level of academic excellence.

DISCOUNTS AND FINANCIAL AID

Sibling Discounts: 2 or more children enrolled – younger sibling(s) receive a \$500 discount per additional child.

Full Prepayment: For the 2019-2020 school year, if payment in full is received by April 10, 2019, there is a 3% tuition discount.

Financial Assistance: Request for financial assistance will be addressed on a case-by-case basis and as funds are available. All requests are kept confidential. Your financial assistance paperwork will not be processed until acceptance to Posnack School is completed. Applications for financial assistance are available at www.posnackschool.org (under the Admissions link). Completed applications must be returned to the school's business office within 10 business days from receipt of your Tuition Agreement.
