



2019-2020 Lower School East and Main Campus Summer Reading

Students Entering Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd Grades:

- Please keep a reading log for all books read over the summer. Students who are not yet reading may have an adult or sibling read aloud to them.
- Each student is encouraged to read **10 books** over the summer.
- Books longer than **50 pages** will count as two.
- Please bring your reading log(s) with you on the first day of school.

Students Entering 3rd Grade:

- Please keep a reading log for all summer reading.
- Each student is encouraged to read a minimum of **2 novels** on their independent reading level over the summer.
- Any novel over **150 pages** will count as two.
- In addition to the novels, any additional reading may be from other types of literature (magazines, newspaper, poetry, etc.).
- Please bring your reading log(s) with you on the first day of school.

Students Entering 4th and 5th Grades:

- Please keep a reading log for all summer reading.
- Each student **must** read a minimum of **2 novels** over the summer. One novel will be the student's choice and should be chosen based on their independent reading level. The other novel should be selected from the two choices listed below. Students should be prepared to write about their novel and answer questions based on the characters, setting, and plot.

4th Grade: Lemonade War by Jacqueline Davies
My Teacher is an Alien by Bruce Coville

5th Grade: Flush by Carl Hiaasen
Maniac Magee by Jerry Spinelli

- Any novel over **200 pages** will count as two.
- Students are encouraged to read more than the required 2 novels, and additional reading may be from other types of literature (magazines, newspaper, poetry, etc.)
- Please bring your reading log(s) with you on the first day of school.
