Directions for Summer Reading:

1. **Read the books.** This might seem obvious, but a lot of students try to get around this basic component of summer reading. Use a strategy such as creating a reading schedule/calendar to help you with your goal. Please purchase the physical book.
2. **Enjoy the experience.** Many students view reading as a chore, but it's meant to be an enjoyable and relaxing form of... dare I say... entertainment. You can read for pleasure. Reading is not a form of medieval torture.
3. **Show up to class with your books the first week of school.** Your first assignment will be an essay about your summer reading.
4. **The Assignment:** For each book you read this summer you're going to send **pretend** text messages to the author. You will "send" a text message every time you read. What should your texts say? Here are some suggestions:
 - Ask a question about what is happening in the book.
 - Share your opinion about the plot, setting, or characters.
 - Tell the author if you're making any personal connections to the text.
 - Be creative! Send the author a suggestion.

The text messages will be "sent" using an online platform: www.goformative.com. Here are the instructions for how to join:

1. Go to www.goformative.com/join
2. Enter the code: 2CFWDK
3. Indicate that you are a student in the class and join using your Posnack student email. **(You can use goformative.com on your computer or your phone!)**
4. You will see 2 assignments – one for each book. Click on an assignment to get started.
