Student Work

1. Please go to [Canvas](#) and click on the Tile “Summer Work - Incoming 5th Grade.”
2. Please open **Task 1**: “Reading Book” and read the story.



You may want to use the “Dictionary” to help you understand the page you read. It may also be a good idea to print it out.

3. Please open the document in **Task 2** called: “Answer questions” and answer the questions by either writing the answers on paper or by typing your answers directly on the document.

If you choose to write answers in your notebook, you will need to take a picture of your writing and upload it to Canvas by choosing “File uploads.”



4. Please choose any 5 pages you would like to read (any five of your choice!) and record your reading.

You can use “Media recordings” to record your work directly to Canvas, or you can use your camera app or voice recorder and then upload it to Canvas by choosing: “File uploads.”

5. Please upload your reading of the 5 pages from the book into **Task 3**: “Upload Reading.”

6. Please open the document listed in **Task 4** and watch the video: “Fun to travel in Israel” by clicking on the link provided.

Watch the video and then answer the questions on the document provided. You may answer the questions in English.



7. Go to **Task 5** and make a fun presentation in Hebrew about what your summer days look like!
- Make sure to add pictures (either real ones or clipart) and add some Hebrew writing to your slides.
 - Be prepared to share it with your 5th grade classmates!
 - Use the presentation provided to help you get started!
